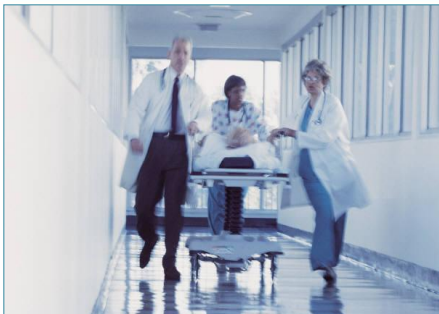


Health Council Program Invitation: NURSE READINESS TRAINING FOR PATIENT EMERGENCIES
